Gloucestershire Wildlife Trust is an independent charity dedicated to protecting the natural environment in Gloucestershire, England.

The Trust initially relied on utility companies providing renewable energy to power its sites. To address this, they explored options to reduce expenses and allocate more funding toward conservation efforts. Acting on a strong recommendation from the Wildfowl and Wetlands Trust, they approached Solarsense for a solution.
